SAINT NICHOLAS, the protector of maidens and children

Saint Nicholas of Bari (Patara III century-Myra 343 AD, Asia Minor) is one of the most popular saints venerated throughout the Eastern and Western Churches. Mentioned by Dante in his Purgatory (XX, 31-33), Nicholas is renowned as the protector of young maidens seeking marriage, and is also cherished around the world as the holy guardian of children, sailors, and merchants.

Saint Nicholas's reputation for generosity and kindness gave rise to stories on his miracles for the poor and unhappy, and several testimonies recount of his provision of a dowry to needy young women. Even today, maidens who wish to get married visit the 11th Century Basilica in Bari, awaiting his blessing.

Just as many legends narrate of Nicholas as having saved children, and in many countries kids receive gifts on December 6, St. Nicholas Day: over the centuries, the Bishop of Myra has become the original legacy of Santa Claus. To this day, Bari is one of the most visited pilgrimage sites from East and West thanks to the city's famous Patron Saint.



The healing powers of Saint Nichola's Manna

Legend has it that after Nicholas passing - on December 6, AD 343 - a unique relic called manna formed in his grave. This substance, said to be curative, fostered the growth of devotion to the Saint of Myra.

Nowadays, after almost 1700 years, this phenomenon is still occurring and was also scientifically examined: the "manna of Saint Nicholas" never ceased exuding from his relics and is therefore highly venerated for its powers.

Every year, on the evening of May 9, the stone sarcophagus held in Bari's Basilica is opened. In the crowded crypt, the Archbishop of Bari extracts one or two glasses of the watery matter formed during the year around the Saint's bones. This is the manna, which is then poured into large containers of blessed water, making a large quantity to fill small bottles so as to satisfy the requests of pilgrims, devotees, and believers from all over the world.



The main town of Puglia and an important touristic destination and commercial harbor, Bari lies on a fertile coastal plain facing the Adriatic Sea.

Between the heart of the Old Town and the sea is Bari's most famous church, the eleventh-century Romanesque Basilica di San Nicola.

Another massive building in the Romanesque style is Cattedrale di San Sabino, dating to the late twelfth century. Close by is the Castello Svevo ('Swabian Castle'), an imposing fortress by the sea. Dotted through the alleys of the Old Town are many other churches, chapels and ruins.

The "new" town mostly consists of wide nineteenth-century streets busy with traffic. The most pleasant thoroughfare is Via Sparano, a high street lined with shops including big high-street brands.

It is worth heading out to the seafront to the east of town, by the old port, the Porto Vecchio.

Here in the mornings you can see fishermen landing in small wooden boats with their catch - and then selling it directly on the waterfront.
